REMARKS

1. WP1 1.2 Study visits to program countries; Current travelling restrictions across partner and program countries; Study visit to Serbia (Subotica)
Current travelling restrictions in the case of Austria and Germany are very high. There is a possibility to organize a study visit to Serbia for BIH partners since the travelling restrictions between Serbia and BIH are low and coordinator will explore this possibility as soon as partial lockdown in Serbia is over.
2. WP1 1.3 Survey of companies needs for DHE in BIH – Report. WP leader: WUS
The report to SC was submitted by Almir Kovačević from WUS. The survey is finished and translation of the report on English language will be finished in two weeks. There were 173 responses from companies. The proposal is to organize a separate meeting about the report as soon as it is distributed to all partners. The key question is how to raise awareness about dual education among companies. DHBW offered an info about the VET system in Germany
3. WP2 2.1 Development of generic DUALSCI model – Presentation of the model. WP leader: UES
Nenad Markovic (UES) presented the model. There were three proposed models with different number of hours in companies. The model was distributed to all partners and they can start working on the specific dual models.
4. WP2 2.2 Conference on DUALSCI added value on industrial sector. Deadline: 14/02/2021
Partners from BIH started to cooperate with industrial sector through two round tables and other meetings already. The proposal is to organize a conference during the Investment Forum in Brčko in September as separate session.
5. WP3 Creation of Legal and Quality Assurance Conditions for Implementation of dual higher education. Deadline for amendments: 14/06/2021
Ms Giulia Moro stressed the importance of work with local authorities and accreditation procedure. Since Erasmus+ office in BIH is organizing the workshop on accreditation in BIH, through technical assistance mission, in April 21-22nd, NEO will send an invitation to representatives of DUALSCI project. Every working group will have their representative at technical assistance meeting on accreditation.
6. WP4 Pilot testing of the generic DUALSCI model: Draft of study programs. Deadline for 4.1 Description and concept of the specific dual models of HEIs: 14/02/2021
Since Generic model of dual education is finished with some delay, the new deadline for specific DE models is 30/4/2021. LC meeting in Mostar on April 15th is good opportunity for BIH partners to discuss development of specific models.
7. WP4 4.3 Agreements with companies interested to participate in the pilot testing of the specific dual models
Working groups in charge of development of specific dual models and legal framework must present the specific models of dual education to companies of interest and start negotiating their involvement into pilot dual study programs, after the April 2021.



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8. WP4, Activity 4.4 Purchase of Equipment – Report from UOM.
Professor Željko Stojkić submitted the report about the purchase of equipment. So far, UES and UNZE finished the purchase completely, while there are some small delays regarding UOM and UNSA related to small number of laptops. By the middle of April, all equipment will be installed. Coordinator reminded the BIH partners to send all the documents related to purchase and installation of equipment.
9. WP6 Dissemination and Exploitation of Results – Report from UNZE. 6.2 Promotional products
Deadline: 14/08/2020
Professor Malik Čabaravdić submitted the report about dissemination. Dissemination activities are going according to dissemination plan. Ms Giulia Moro drawn attention to some modules on the website, still without content (Project Info/Background and project Info/Description). In addition, once more she underlined the priority of dissemination to local authorities.

The proposal is for four partners from BIH to organize a meeting with authorities, before the accreditation workshop.

10. WP7, Activity 7.4 Reporting – Report from UNS (Radmila Bjekic, project administrator)
Professor Mirko Savić submitted the report. There are still missing ITR reports and supporting document about the trip to kick off meeting in February 2020 from IMH, DHBW, UNZE, and representatives of ministry from Zenica-Doboj canton.
