plus project "Capacity building in the implementation of dual education in BiH higher education (DUALSCI)" and the program "European Entrepreneurship Network Serbian (EUNORS)".

The panel discussion was attended by representatives of the University of East Sarajevo, Vice-Rector for Human and Material Resources Prof. dr Srdjan Lalic and doc. Dr. Nenad Markovic from the Faculty of Medicine.

The panel was also attended by a representative of the Chamber of Commerce of the Republic of Srpska, the director of the sector for economic and legal affairs Dragana Kokot, and a representative of the Faculty of Economics at the University of Novi Sad, Danilo Đokić, MA.

The basic processes and postulates of the dual higher education system are defined, preliminary results of research conducted on the territory of Republika Srpska among economic organizations regarding the establishment of dual education are presented, the state of dual education in the Republic of Serbia and short cycle studies are reviewed, and the potential contribution of short study cycles and dual education to the entire education system in Republika Srpska.
